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Dior a jewel in Queens Plaza crown

Christian Dior, founded in 1946 has come to be known for the finest perfumes, make-up, skincare, accessories, gifts and of course fashion. The brand's arrival as a stand-alone boutique in Brisbane's Queen's Plaza positions itself in a prominent location at the main entrance and takes up 265M2 with two imposing full height facades.

The project, led by Josh
Turner presented significant
challenges including a raised
floor and the façade structure
itself which incorporates grey
marble surrounded by white
texture marble accentuating
polished stainless show windows.

The store has a full Ladies offering and features separate rooms for shoes, ready to wear and accessories. The finishes are subtle yet luxurious with an unusually varied range of textures that blend seamlessly into each other.

Moncler's second Australian store



Our second store for the famous Italian lifestyle brand that found its name on the slopes of a French Alpine town near Grenoble (Monestier-de-Clermont) is located at Sydney's Westfield and features a striking chevron patterned marble runway lit by the coffered ceiling above.

The store itself has dark tones in timber and metal throughout with the ready to wear racks highlighted from behind with illuminated Calacatta Vagli, which brings the product to the fore beautifully.

Delivered by Projects Team Manager Josh Turner, this is another outstanding result for the brand "Although our second build, it was no less challenging than the first project" said Josh.



ANZAC Square, Brisbane

As a homage to our returned service men and women and fallen heroes, it was an honour to undertake this project in collaboration with Lightwell Studio and X2 Design. The project's requirement was to deliver new interactive displays to various areas as well as a significant covering screen over the existing illuminated mosaic commemorating those who served in WW2. The covering structure had to be a feature itself, with the ability to be dismantled to display the mosaic originally designed by Mr Don Ross in 1959.

With the number of interactive screens throughout, we worked closely with the specialist team from Rutledge AV to ensure connectivity throughout this heritage sensitive space. The project was overseen by Pradeep V Raja as part of the renovation to ANZAC Square undertaken by the Brisbane City Council in 2018.
